How it works

Ryerson Eats Community Meal Plans use declining balance technology similar to a debit card, but without the fees. Funds are loaded onto your OneCard, and the cost of your meals and snacks are deducted from your balance when you swipe. You can also use your Meal Plan for purchases at vending machines throughout campus, except those registered for the tax exempt Option 1.

As the semester progresses, you can add additional dollars to your Meal Plan, with a minimum load value of \$100. Your Community Meal Plan doesn't expire, but we'll place a hold on it at the end of the academic year to protect your remaining balance. When you return to campus for your next academic term, simply reactivate your balance by visiting the OneCard office (JOR02) at 380 Victoria Street.

Refunds on any remaining balance of a Meal Plan are available; however, an administrative flat fee of \$2.50 will be charged on any refunds of balances below \$50. Refunds of balances more than \$50 will be charged at a 5% administrative fee on any remaining funds. Please refer to the One Card website at ryerson.ca/OneCard for more details.

Refund Policy

Refunds can be requested in person, at the OneCard Office during business hours with OneCard Photo ID. Any Campus Fund, Meal Plan, Dine & Vend or Laundry Fund is subject to an administrative fee. Bonus amounts part of the original purchase are non-refundable. OneCards are active from September 1st to August 31st of the academic year. The card is automatically reactivated each September based on your registration with the University. All funds are carried over year-to-year with your continued enrollment at the University. If as of September 1st of an academic year you do not return to the University as a registered student, you have until October 31st of that year to claim any remaining balance. Refunds not claimed within the noted period become the Property of the University. For current meal plan policy information, visit ryerson.ca/onecard.
